

Code of Conduct

Spectators

Saltire Team Gymnastics is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its gymnasts. The club believes it is important that gymnasts, coaches and parents should, at all times, respect and understand the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, gymnasts and parents are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns they may have with their child's coach or one of our Safeguarding Officers. The clubs Codes of Conduct fully adopts Scottish Gymnastics Policies and Procedures.

Spectators must:

- Switch mobile phones to silent during competitions and events
- Follow the rules related to photography during the event
- Remain supportive throughout the competition and must not interfere with other spectators' enjoyment or disturb any of the gymnasts
- Refrain from moving about the seating area whilst gymnasts are competing
- Remain in the spectator seating area and not enter the controlled areas including competition field of play and the control desk
- Treat the competition venues with respect, particularly in respect of food and drink rules
- Respect all competitors, coaches and competition officials

The Competition Organiser reserves the right to remove any spectators in breach of this Code of Conduct
